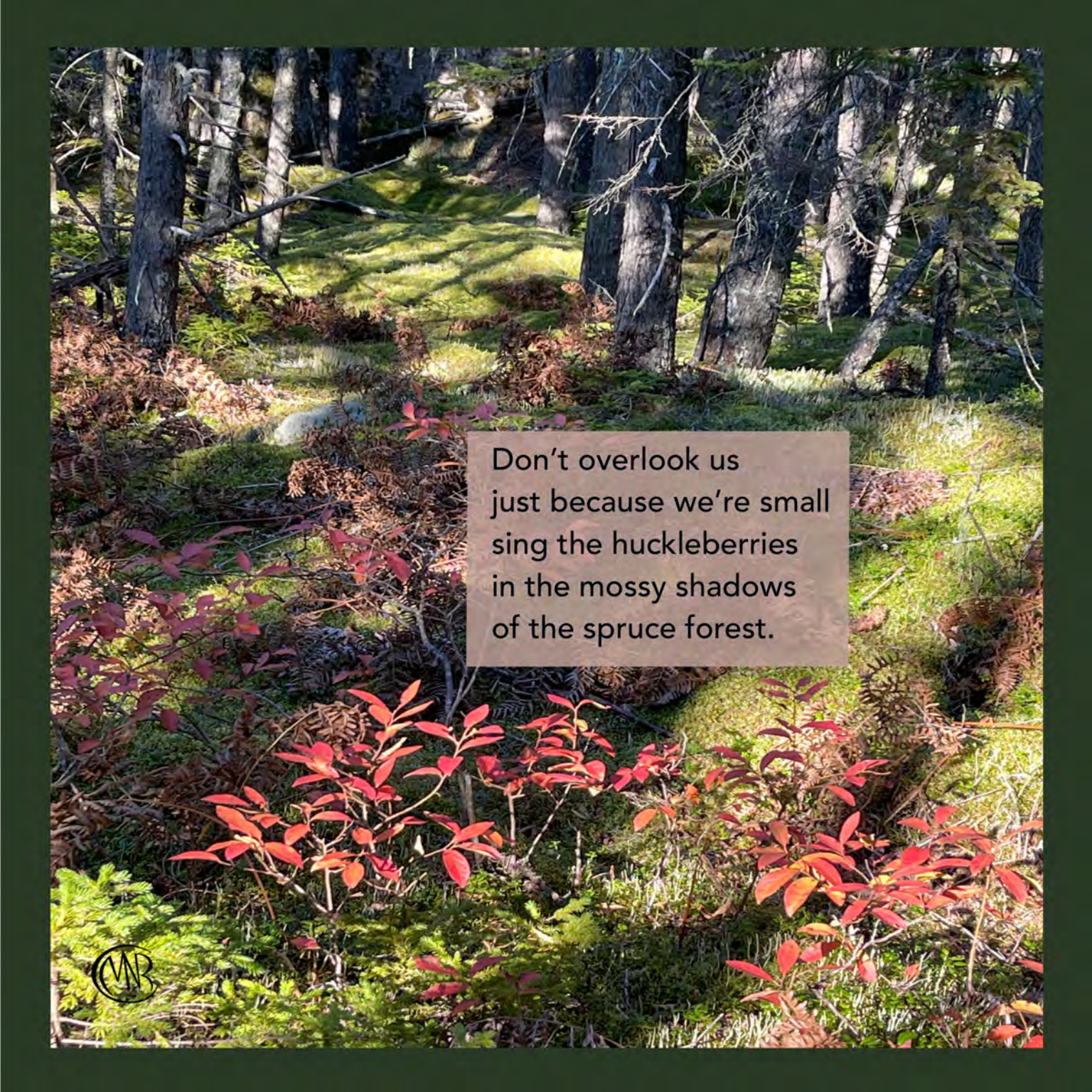

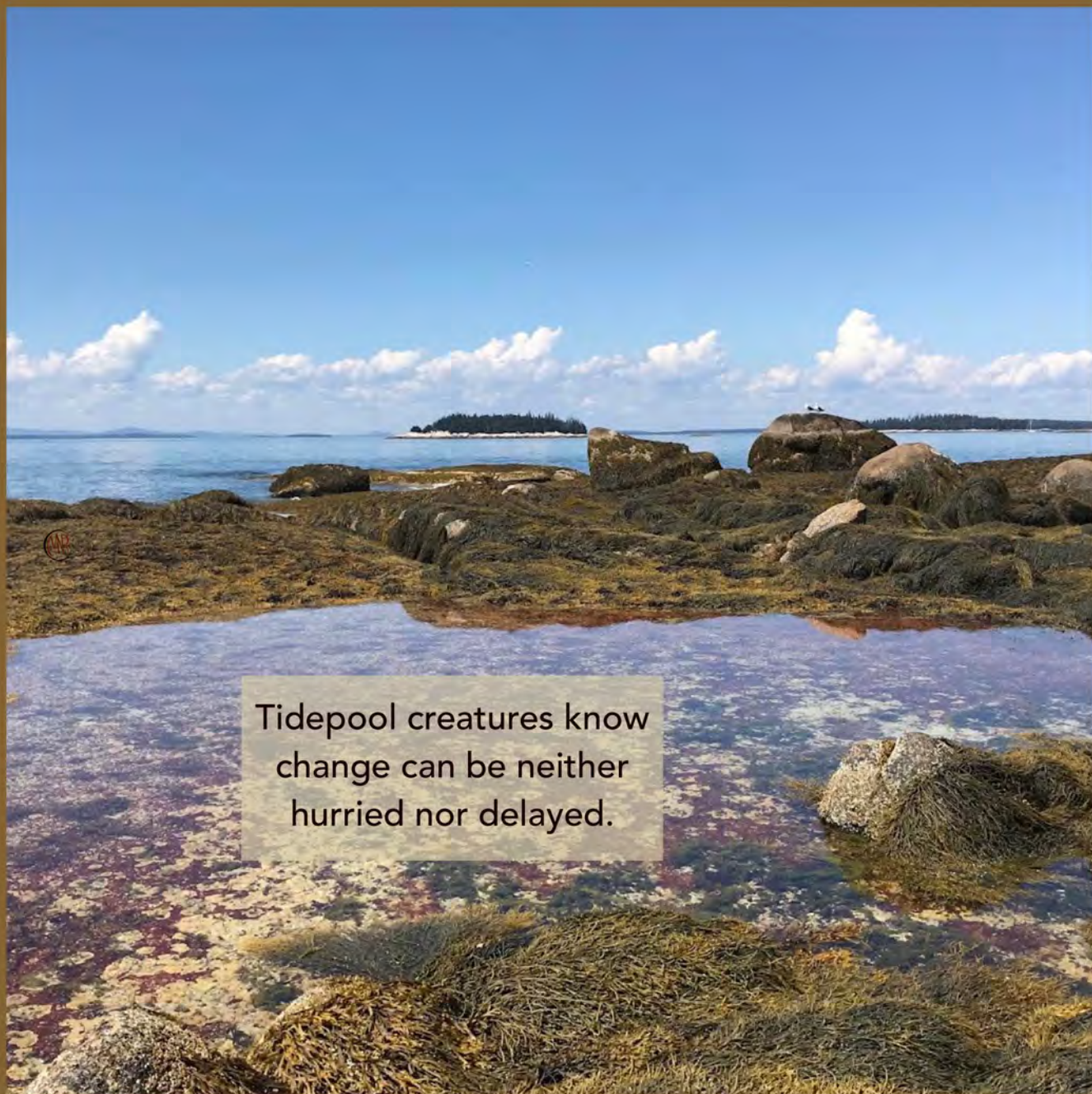


Simple grace

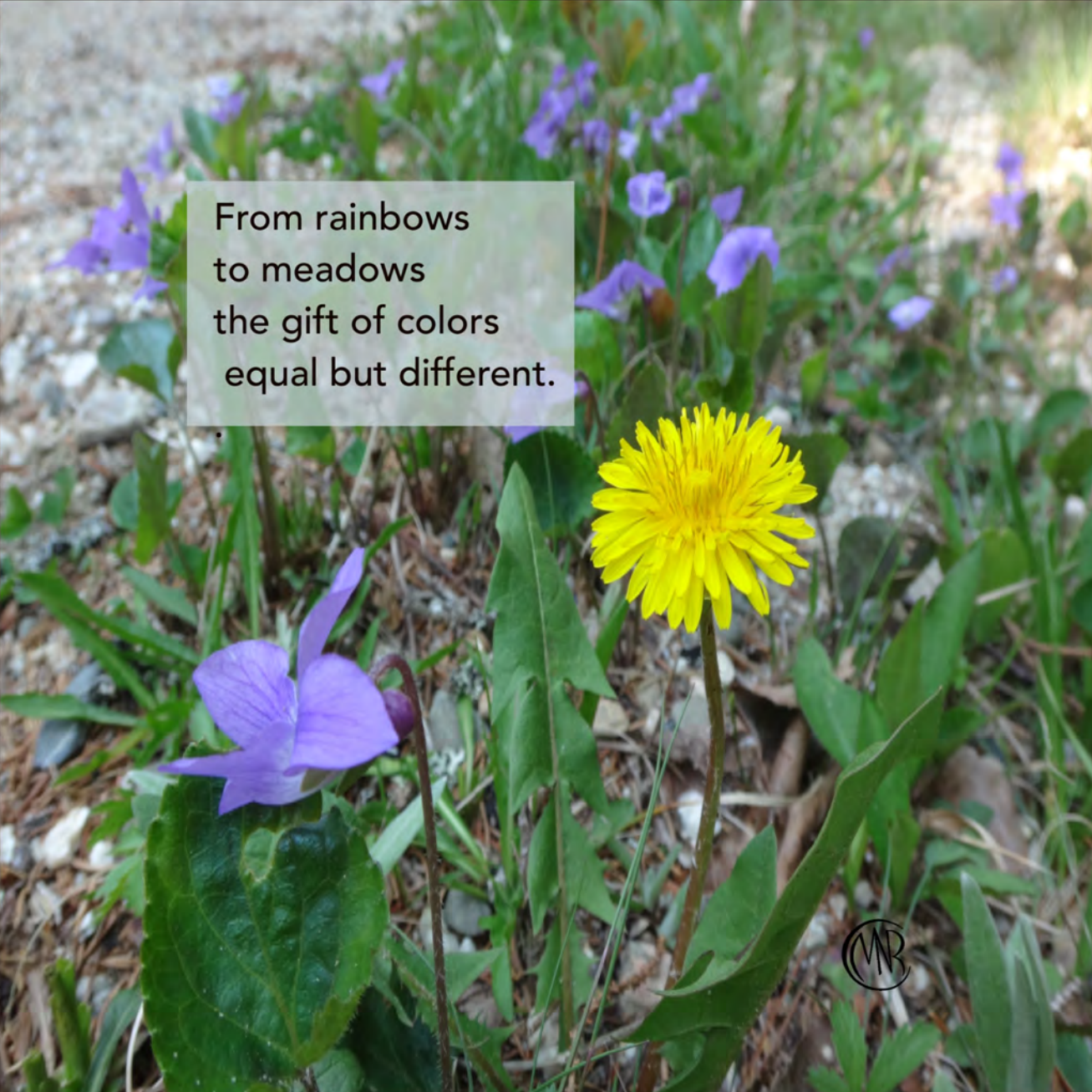

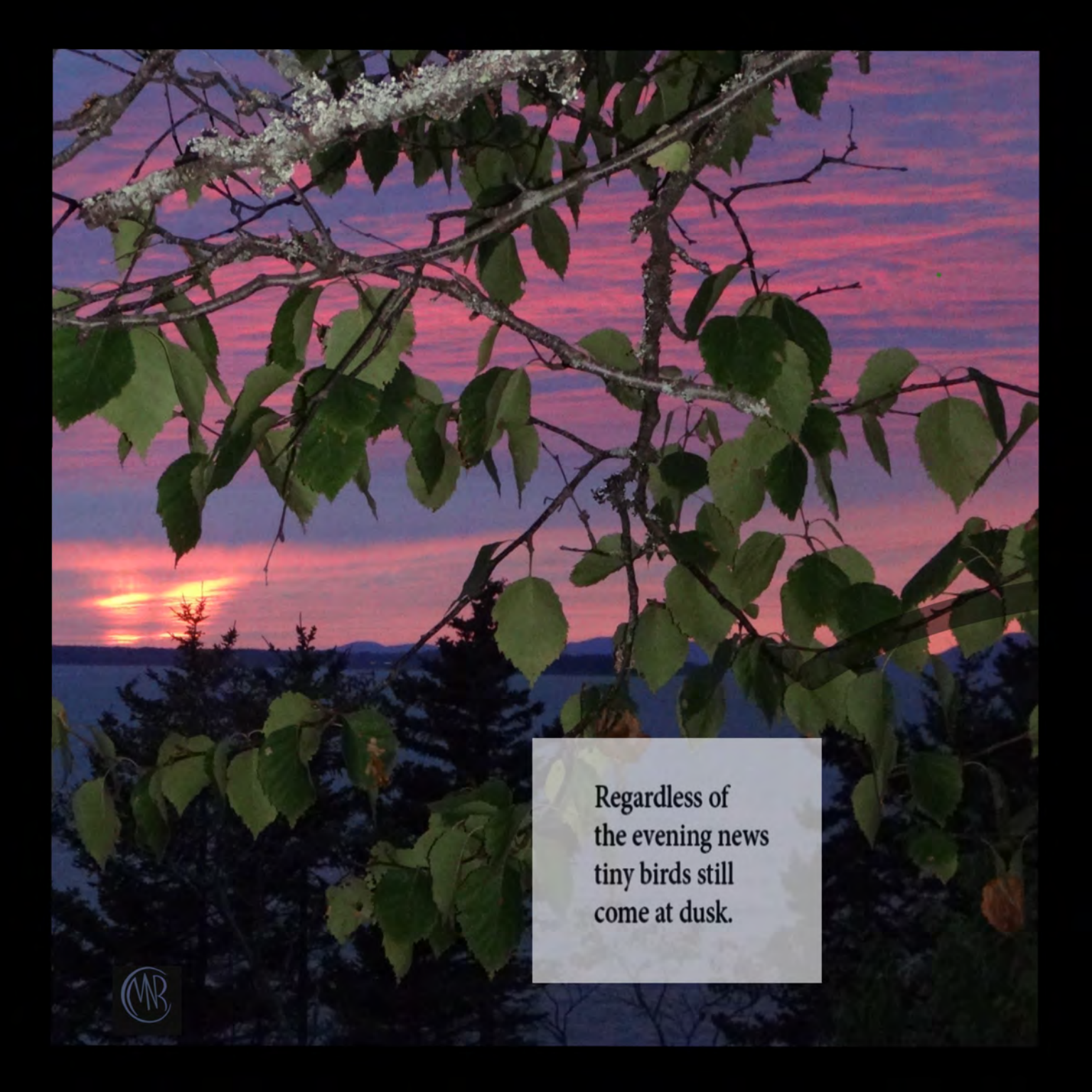


Tidepool creatures know

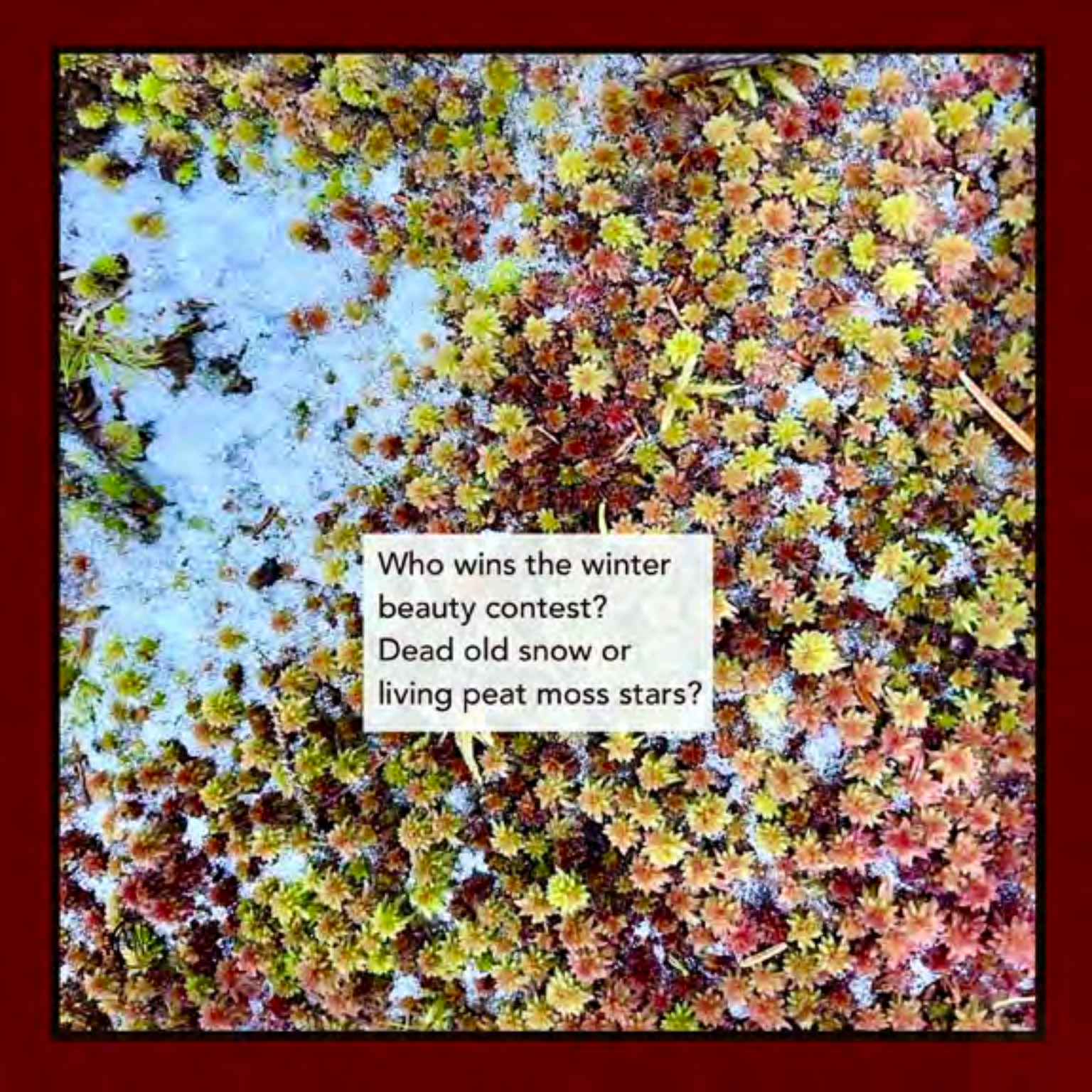
